Now more than ever, encouraging infants and young children to practice skills like selfregulation, social engagement, problem-solving and play is critical. During these uncertain times, families and children are experiencing unprecedented stress and challenges. Especially our families of children with special needs. Families need opportunities to recover from adversity, heal from trauma and get stronger again. They need safe places and, at times, guidance to grow. Working to strengthen families gives us hope in a stronger community and a brighter future. This presentation will focus on understanding the complex needs of all family members and the impact of quarantine on parent stress, children with special needs and navigating the early start to school district transition process. We will also explore strategies to support stress management, sensory, educational and social-emotional needs in families.



ABOUT THE SPEAKER: Laura Counts, MA, is a Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist and is the Assistant Clinical Director at the Child Development Institute in Reseda, CA. Laura provides training and consultation to a variety of professionals in the areas of early development, strengthening families, challenging behaviors, reflective practice and trauma-informed care. Laura also supervises the CDI Early Learning Center, a free, drop-in play center whose programs promote the protective factors framework. Laura is endorsed as an Infant-Family and Early Childhood Mental Health Specialist and Reflective Practice Facilitator II by the California Center for Infant-Family and Early Childhood Mental Health. She also focuses on Social Emotional Foundations of Early Learning Coach, a clinical supervisor of MFT Trainee's and Associates and was a Lead Trainer and Consultant with Zero to Three on the Prenatal through Three Workforce Development Project.

Esta presentación se centrará en comprender las necesidades complejas de todos los miembros de la familia y el impacto que la cuarentena hace en el estrés de los padres, los niños con necesidades especiales y como navegar los servicios Intervencion Temprana y la transición a los distritos escolares. También exploraremos estrategias para apoyar el manejo del estrés, sensorial, educación y

necesidades socio-emocionales en las familias.



ACERCA DE LA PRESENTADORA: Laura Counts, MA, es una terapeuta con licenciatura en matrimonio y familia y es la Asistente Directora Clínica del Child Development Institute en Reseda, CA.

Laura provee entrenamiento y consulta a varios profesionales en las áreas de desarrollo temprano, fortaleciendo familias, comportamientos desafiantes, practica reflectiva, y atención informada sobre el trauma.

Laura supervisa el CDI Early Learning Center, un centro de juego gratuito cuyos programas promueven la estructura de factores de protección.

Laura está capacitada como Especialista en Salud Mental Infantil,

Familiar y de la Primera Infancia y es Facilitadora de Práctica Reflectiva II por el mismo centro.
